Comments: The afterschool educators do not have documentation of their planning (web/notebook, etc...). Educator's must be able to demonstrate that they are purposeful in their planning for and with the children.			
24(1) For the purposes of subsection 20(1) of the Act, the following records and documents shall be maintained on the premises of a licensed facility: (b) child records that include: (iv) the name, address and telephone number of at least two individuals authorized by the child's parent or guardian to pick up the child and to be contacted in case of an emergency if the parent or guardian cannot be reached,	24(1)(b)(iv)	Jul 31, 2020	
Comments: Many of the audited records have incomplete addresses for the emergency contacts (must include the city). One has an emergency contact that is more than 1 hour away. Must have contacts that can pick up the child within 1 hour. One file has an emergency contact that is missing the person's last name. Must have first and last name to be able to check the identification if they pick up the child. The Operator must ensure that the emergency contacts in all files are complete.			
24(1) For the purposes of subsection 20(1) of the Act, the following records and documents shall be maintained on the premises of a licensed facility: (b) child records that include: (v) the child's health history and a copy of the record of immunizations or a copy of an exemption.	24(1)(b)(v)	Jul 31, 2020	
Comments: One of the audited files does not have a copy of the immunization record, or exemption. Operator must obtain a copy and place in the file.			
30(3) An operator shall maintain the indoor play area of a licensed facility to ensure the safety of the children.	30(3)	Jul 22, 2020	Jul 22, 2020
Comments: A protective receptacle cover is missing in the preschool room; a cover must be placed in the outlet. Was corrected during inspection. Deficiency is now compliant			
47(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall refuse admission to a child if satisfactory proof of the immunizations required by the Public Health Act or the regulations under that Act is not provided.	47(1)	Jul 31, 2020	
Comments: One of the audited files does not have a copy of the immunization record, or exemption. Operator must obtain a copy and place in the file. Operator must ensure that this information is collected from all families during enrollment and prior to the child's entry.
