Comments: In 1 of the audited children's files, the signed consent for administering medication is not filled out. Recommendation that Corporation Director review all children's records to ensure that all required consents have been signed.

Comments: In 1 of the audited children's files, the signed consent for permitting photographs and videos of child for publication or social media is not filled out. Recommendation that Corporation Director review all children's records to ensure that all required consents have been signed.			
27 An operator of a licensed facility shall obtain the written consent of a parent or guardian of a child receiving services at the licensed facility before doing any of the following: (k) posting photographs of the child at the licensed facility to illustrate the child's learning.	27(k)	Jul 25, 2022	
Comments: In 1 of the audited children's files, the signed consent for posting photographs of child in the centre to illustrate learning is not filled out. Recommendation that Corporation Director review all children's records to ensure that all required consents have been signed.

Corporation Director must ensure that all medication be placed under lock and key. Medication was placed under lock and key while Inspector was on site. Deficiency is now compliant.</p>

<p>Comments: During the inspection, Inspector found a hot beverage on a high shelf in one of the classrooms. This beverage belongs to a staff from an outside agency. Corporation Director must ensure that there are no hot beverages permitted children's play areas. The hot beverage was removed immediately. Deficiency is now compliant</p>
