Comments: During the renewal inspection, Inspector observed a group that was over ratio. This was addressed with the educator and the operator came into the classroom immediately to meet ratio. Inspector also observed a preschool aged child napping. The curtains were drawn to block the light from the child who was napping, which was preventing the educator to have direct supervision of this child. A discussion was had with the educator, who opened the curtain in order to ensure that the child was supervised. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments:	The daily attendance records are maintained on-site, however certain information is missing on these. Inspector observed that the educators did not indicate the arrival time of all the children on their daily attendance records. This was added immediately.									
Inspector also observed that the absences codes are not consistently indicated on the daily attendance records in order to determine the reason for the child's absence. Inspector also observed that the departure time for the children was not indicated on two separate occasions. The daily attendance records were also not brought outside by all educators during outdoor play. An attendance record was brought out to an educator during the inspection. Operator must ensure that all required information is indicated on daily attendance records and that the attendance records are always with the educators.

Comments: During the renewal inspection, inspector observed the school aged children arriving. An educator was getting ready to leave to go pick up more children and inspector observed a school aged child get into the vehicle. Inspector explained to the Operator that this not permitted, as there is not consent for this outing. Operator asked the child to come out of the vehicle immediately. As consent is only provided by the parents to provide transportation to and from school, a separate consent must be filled out for motor vehicle outings. Operator must ensure that consent forms for any motor vehicle									
trips will be separate and for each outing.

Inspector observed positive interactions between the educators and the children, such as getting on their level to interact with them and giving them words of encouragement. Educators were heard singing songs with the children.									
A discussion was had with the Operator regarding the outdoor play requirements with regards to the Act. Recommendation that Operator review section 7.2 of the Operator manual pertaining to the Daily Routine to obtain more information regarding outdoor play.
