General Comments

- -Visit to the learning center for an unexpected monitoring inspection
- -Ratio was respected during the visit
- -Outdoor play area is maintained safe and free of hazards. It was mentioned to the operator that snow and ice do not count has protective surfacing.
- -Children's guidance is done in a respectful and positive way
- -The parent is being asked to notify the operator/director the reason why the child is absent, whether it's sickness or another reason
- -When a child who becomes ill, he/she is supervised and separated from the other children. That child is to be picked up within one hour of notification to parents.
- -Management of potential illness forms are completed as required, discussion with the director on appendix 11 & 12 in the operator's manual.
- -Parents are advised when a child has a communicable disease or illness, center does use the notice of illness form (appendix 13, in the operator's manual)
- -We also talk about the importance to give all parents the appendix 14-Managing illness in ELC facilities- parent' s/guardian's role, which she does every year.
- -Each child has an easily accessible space for personal belongings, which is labeled with the name of the child and used only for the intended child.
- -Daily incident log is maintained; parent is informed of reportable incidents as soon as possible and signs the report which is kept in the children's file.
- -Operator advises the Department within 24 hours of reportable incidents

Observations: Children are now into music, the operator shares with the group her piano, guitars, ukulele, accordion, and drums every day they explore with the instrument. Snack was on the table, children arrived from school, everybody participates on getting the snack ready, sat down ate their snack, shared their day, danced, and went outside to play ball hockey.
