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General Comments It was naptime when licensing staff arrived. Older preschool children that did not nap were combined in the school age room over naptime allowing them the opportunity to play with older peers and explore different resources. Ratio was maintained at all times. Children were engaged in play as they have free play time immediately following lunch. One educator invited a child to play a board game with other children joining in and the second educator sat with children in the cozy corner reading a book to the children. Documentation was evident throughout the centre in the hallways and in rooms. Learning stories, photos, and updates are provided to parents on class dojo and the educators are also posting documentation at the children's level throughout the centre remembering that children are at the heart of curriculum. Documentation posted throughout each space for children to view allows children to re-visit their learning and support their learning identity within the space. The school age educators have planned weekly ideas for the summer based on children's interests and requests. They have celebrated a sports week, Hawaiian week, and this week is science week. Documentation for each week is posted with children's photos, quotes, and descriptions. The educator shared photos and comments on science week with the creation of a volcano, painting, and then eruption over several days and multiple invitations offered each day to explore scientific inquiry. New staff files were reviewed. Job descriptions were missing from very recent educators, but the administrator was rectifying it immediately. The preschool room is currently being reorganized and prepared for a new preschool group.
