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General Comments Licensing staff arrived at the facility at 2:45pm to conduct a monitoring inspection. Upon arriving the children had not yet arrived on site. Around 3pm, the educators and children were observed walking from school to the facility. Licensing staff introduced themselves and followed the group side of the facility. The children were observed placing their personal belongings on their hooks and changed their shoes before heading to the washrooms to wash their hands. A verbal prompt was given to the children to gather their afternoon snack and take a seat at the tables. The tables were sanitized before the children sat down to eat. The educator was heard having conversations with the children as they ate. After eating, the children engaged in a drawing activity as a group and then proceeded to engage in various free play activities such as playing with Legos. In another rooms, a small group of children were observed drawing at a table with an educator supervising them. The educator was heard asking questions about the children's drawings and praising them for their artwork. During this time, some children were observed engaging in various free play activities such as playing with Legos, baby dolls, drawing and playing with "Polly Pockets" and "Pet Shops". The play materials were well stored and located at an accessible height for the children to access. A verbal prompt was given to the children to start cleaning up before going outside. The children then gathered their personal belongings before going outside to play. A first aid bag and daily attendance was taken outside on the playground. While outside, some children were observed playing "Four Square" while others engaged in imaginary play in the dramatic playhouse/ kitchen. The indoor environment was clean, safe, and well organized. The cleaning products were locked by key in one of the play areas. Evacuation procedures and important informations were posted in a visible area at the entrance. The children's personal belongings were properly stored in designated area.
