Comments:	The children were observed to be very creative within their outdoor environment today. Additional outdoor play materials and equipment are needed to further support this. The children appeared interested in baking and dramatic play opportunities that they are creating outdoors. Possible materials to be added include mixing bowls, cupcake pans, cookie sheets, utensils, wooden spoons, tongs, spatulas etc,. A mud kitchen or another open ended dramatic play structure would also be a nice addition to this space to support the children's interests in: drive-through, gas station, bakery etc.					

General Comments

Renewal inspection was completed today.

Environments were set up and ready for the children to explore. Educators were observed supporting the children's exploration and modelling how to resolve social conflicts as they occurred.

Outdoor play occurred prior to lunch time this morning for the preschool children.

Hand washing occurred prior to eating lunch. Rest time was briefly observed.

Discussed fire drill forms and that these can be completed as operator wishes, provided that the mandatory information is recorded and the date/year is evident for each month.

Recommending that an Essential and Routine Services plan is completed for one child with a medical condition.

This should be completed by the parent and reviewed annually to ensure all information is up to date.

The school aged children's outdoor play area requires a general clean up to discard broken materials and

equipment. Recommending the addition of an outdoor storage box with a lid so that the children can care for and preserve their materials. A picnic table or child size chairs would also be a nice addition to the outdoor play space.
