27 An operator of a licensed facility shall obtain the written consent of a parent or guardian of a child receiving services at the licensed facility before doing any of the following: (g) transporting or providing for the transportation of the child.	27(g)	Sep 30, 2022	
Comments: Random review of child files. Missing consent for transporting school aged children by walking. Operator printed consent forms and will have parents sign and add to child files.			
28(3) The premises of a licensed facility shall comply with (a) lighting, ventilation and other general health standards under the Public Health Act.	28(3)(a)	Sep 30, 2022	
Comments: The hot water will not currently turn off completely in washroom on school aged side of building. Tap to be fixed as soon as possible. Finish on sink bowl is in poor repair (chipped) and must be replaced to ensure proper cleaning. Younger children who had diaper changes today washed their hands in the preschool washroom following the change. These children must wash their hands within the washroom in which they are changed to prevent transmission of communicable disease. Garbage can lid is not opening with foot pedal within preschool washroom. Foot pedal to be repaired or replaced.			
30(3) An operator shall maintain the indoor play area of a licensed facility to ensure the safety of the children.	30(3)	Oct 14, 2022	
Comments: Trim, (particularly around the door between rooms), baseboards and some doors require paint touch ups throughout the building as they are marked up or showing wear.			
31(3) An operator shall maintain the outdoor play area of a licensed facility to ensure the safety of the children.	31(3)	Sep 26, 2022	
Comments: Wood on outdoor table and bench seat within the school aged outdoor play area are splintering-discard and replace. There are also some broken toys/equipment throughout the woods and outdoor play area. Recommending that the children do a clean up with the educators and then make a list of the materials to be replaced.			
32(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall provide indoor play area materials and equipment that are (d) clean and in good repair.	32(1)(d)	Sep 30, 2022	
Comments: Black wooden coat hook on wall near block construction area is loose and coming away from wall-to be reaffixed or moved. If removed, paint will need to be touched up. Material is peeling off of one reclining chairs on preschool side-to be repaired with proper patching kit or removed.

33(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall provide outdoor play area materials and equipment that are varied and in sufficient quantity for the number and ages of the children receiving services at the licensed facility.	33(1)	Oct 14, 2022	
Comments: The children were observed to be very creative within their outdoor environment today. Additional outdoor play materials and equipment are needed to further support this. The children appeared interested in baking and dramatic play opportunities that they are creating outdoors. Possible materials to be added include mixing bowls, cupcake pans, cookie sheets, utensils, wooden spoons, tongs, spatulas etc., A mud kitchen or another open ended dramatic play structure would also be a nice addition to this space to support the children's interests in: drive-through, gas station, bakery etc.			

General Comments
<p>Renewal inspection was completed today.</p> <p>Environments were set up and ready for the children to explore. Educators were observed supporting the children's exploration and modelling how to resolve social conflicts as they occurred.</p> <p>Outdoor play occurred prior to lunch time this morning for the preschool children.</p> <p>Hand washing occurred prior to eating lunch. Rest time was briefly observed.</p> <p>Discussed fire drill forms and that these can be completed as operator wishes, provided that the mandatory information is recorded and the date/year is evident for each month.</p> <p>Recommending that an Essential and Routine Services plan is completed for one child with a medical condition. This should be completed by the parent and reviewed annually to ensure all information is up to date.</p> <p>The school aged children's outdoor play area requires a general clean up to discard broken materials and equipment. Recommending the addition of an outdoor storage box with a lid so that the children can care for and preserve their materials. A picnic table or child size chairs would also be a nice addition to the outdoor play space.</p>
