General Comments					

A renewal inspection was conducted today. During the visit, children were actively engaged in a variety of activities across both indoor and outdoor learning environments.

Artistic expression was prominently featured throughout the facility, with multiple forms of child-led artwork displayed. Paintings were visible in both indoor and outdoor areas, and children were observed drawing and creatively tracing a dinosaur figure using its shadow cast by the sun.

In one instance, a group of children collaboratively constructed a structure using magnetic blocks, thoughtfully describing its components as representing "water, lava, and grass," and naming each figure involved.

Both environments featured inviting quiet corners stocked with numerous books that reflected the children's current interests, supporting literacy and self-directed exploration.

Outdoors, children had created an extensive network of paths through the bushes adjacent to the facility, incorporating a variety of natural and loose materials. They enthusiastically shared their creations with the inspector, explaining the purpose and destination of each path, which included imaginative spaces such as a "pretend mall," a "spa for parents," and a "Claire's" store.

Staff were actively engaged with the children throughout the inspection. One educator was observed reading a favorite novel aloud, capturing the attention of the entire group as the children gathered to listen attentively. This interaction highlighted the strong relationships and responsive care present within the learning environment.

All cleaning supplies were safely stored and inaccessible to children. Licensing contact information, inspection and monitoring reports were clearly posted and easily visible on the parent information board. Staff and children's files were reviewed, up to date and complete.
