Comments: Deficiency is now compliant			
28(3) The premises of a licensed facility shall comply with (a) lighting, ventilation and other general health standards under the Public Health Act.	28(3)(a)	Jun 25, 2020	
Comments: The one way arrows on the floor are still covered by cubby structures. Supervisor reported that the room will be rearranged to improve division of groups and arrows will be uncovered. Arrows need to be visible and all children should be aware of traffic pathways. Please go over this with children once space has been rearranged (Previously discussed June 23/20). Children must be monitored during hand washing to ensure they are washing their hands correctly. Some educators were monitoring this today, but others were not (Previous comply by date of June 23/20). Many educators observed wearing masks again today, touching their masks and faces without hand washing after. Masks are not to be worn by educators in their regular interactions with children. If masks are used when screening or covering breaks within another room, hand washing must occur each time the mask is readjusted (Previous comply by date of June 23/20). Sanitizing solution was not readily available within each grouping. Educator would need to enter another group to access sanitizing solution for their side. Each grouping must have their own spray bottle within their designated space.			
39(2) A licensed facility shall have a separate locked storage space that is inaccessible to the children for each of the following: (a) toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies;	39(2)(a)	Jun 25, 2020	
Comments: Storage closet containing toxic products near bathroom was unlocked and door was left open today. Staff were notified and door was closed and locked at the time of inspection.			
43 An operator of a licensed facility shall not permit hot beverages in areas that are occupied by the children receiving services at the licensed facility, including the outdoor play area.	43	Jun 25, 2020	
Comments: Coffee was on the main desk upon arrival this morning. Hot beverages are not to be within the children's play space.			

General Comments

Follow up to previous monitoring inspection completed today. Some improvements were noted, but orders for compliance remain.
Facility is now using a non-contact thermometer for temperature readings for children under 12 years of age. Please ensure that only a non contact thermometer is used for this age group going forward.
Recommending that the washroom cleaning checklist is signed each time the washroom is cleaned. Current documented checklist only shows that the bathroom is being cleaned once/day.
Bathrooms must be cleaned frequently throughout the day.
