 Hand washing must occur before and after using the playground equipment. Some educators were wearing masks today (during screening or when needing to enter into another group's space). Hand washing is not happening after masks are handled/adjusted. Educators must wash hands after removing or adjusting masks (Previous comply by date of June 25/20) Screening: Temperature checks-Some children under the age of 12 are being screened using the thermometer without contact. For children under 12 years of age, a contact thermometer (armpit or ear) must be used. The thermometer on site is the correct type, however, it was used improperly today at time of inspection (Previously discussed on June 25/20, see report).

Ensure documented protocols for all life threatening medications are reviewed with all staff immediately. For children with Epipen's and other life threatening allergies, an Allergy Management and Emergency Plan should be completed. See Appendix 4 in Operator Manual. This document should be stored within the child's file and a copy kept with the medication. These medications should be unlocked but inaccessible to children. This child's Epipen was found later today following the inspection after brought to the staff's attention.

posted, and each group has their own sanitizing solution), however orders for compliance still remain. More staff training is required around Epipen's and Allergy Management and Emergency Plans. Please review with all staff and ensure that all staff are aware of all children who have life threatening allergies and their protocols. Each room should have a designated area (bins or backpacks) to store Epipen's or medications for life threatening conditions that is unlocked but inaccessible to children. Ensure that a copy of the Allergy Management and Emergency Plan is stored with the child's medication.
