General Comments			
Monitoring Inspection:			

This morning it was observed that transition times before swimming are too long for the children. These transition times are to be purposefully planned with activities that are engaging for the children. Examples of activities that can be included, but are not limited to; group games in the field, circle games, art station set up at the picnic table, trivia, challenges, group conversations, etc.

Recommend assigning each staff member a role during transitions. Example of roles; supervising changing area, collecting attendance, supervising children applying sunscreen and engaging children in an activity.

A variety of materials are accessible to the children throughout the environment. The environment appears to be well maintained.

Discussed with educators having invitations and activities prepared for when the children arrive in the morning, when they return from outdoor play and after lunch.

Job Descriptions within most of the staff files currently are specific to After School Programs. To be updated as some educators are working as support workers or day camp counselors for the summer.
