Checks were observed and complete, as well as all staff files and random review of children's files.

Inspector had conversation with admin about individual centers being set up when the follow up is conducted. Materials were moved around to accommodate games the children were playing. Learning environments need to be inspiring and invite engagement of all the senses. Also note admin will send paint work order once complete to mark as compliant.
