Comments: 4 year old room- Documentation of children's current learning not evident. As discussed during monitoring inspection when new interest topics are started, it is important to keep documentation of other interests in the environment to allow children to continue or revisit past experiences and learning. Children's learning must be visible through a variety of forms of documentation. Documenting children's learning demonstrates that educators are thinking about children's learning as individuals and group members and supports educators to plan activities, the indoor and outdoor play environment and invitations to learning.

Items can include but are not limited to- paper of various texture and size, cupcake liners, cotton makeup pads, wooden letters, numbers and shapes, popsicle sticks, feathers, straws, coffee filters, yarn and thread, sticks and other items from nature etc.  4 year old room- dramatic play materials lacking.
