Comments: Infant Room - one soother was observed sitting on the counter. Pacifiers and soothers are to be labelled with the name of the child, used only for the intended child, and stored separately for each child.			

General Comments
A Monitoring Inspection was completed this morning. The children in the infant room were walking / crawling around, looking at books, playing with baby dolls, and engaging in ball play. Educators were very engaged – on the children's level, playing, and talking to the children. The children in the 2's room were observed sitting on a mat, in the reading corner, actively listening to a story being read. Children's interests included Books, Paw Patrol, Building Blocks, and Babies. Children were also observed washing their hands after using the bathroom. Several different forms of documentation were observed on the walls. The 3's and 4's were observed during outside play. Smiles and laughs could be heard upon entering the outside play area. Children played in the snow, in the playhouses, and with toy vehicles. A conversation was had with Administrator regarding the fence in the infant play area. Part of the fence was damaged during snow removal services. Operator is aware and has already reached out to Fundy Fencing. Fence will be repaired once the ground thaws.
