General Comments

A Monitoring Inspection was completed this morning. Children were observed during inside play. Detailed documentation - (photos of activities and children's artwork, with descriptions and dates) were observed in each of the classrooms. Infant Room - Children were observed painting with paint brushes and fingers / hands. Children were observed smiling and covered from head to toe, in blue paint. A bubble machine was also set up in the infant room, and infants were observed smiling, laughing, and reaching for the bubbles. Two's Room -Children were observed washing their hands, before playing with Play Doh. Children were excited for Play Doh. - hurrying to the sink to wash up before play, and then hurrying back to the Play Doh table. Educator stated that playing with Play Doh was one of their favorite activities. Other present interests include Oceans, Pirates, and Fish. Three's Room - Children were observed playing with baby dolls and doctor kits, preparing picnics, and playing with toy vehicles. Educators were observed sitting with the children and taking part in their activities. Four's Room - Children were observed during imaginary play - playing house -sleeping under a tarp tent, and preparing a treasure chest, for a future Treasure Hunt. Educators were engaged - offering suggestions and asking open ended questions.
