A Monitoring Inspection was completed this morning. The full day, 4/5 classroom was observed. Children were observed taking part in several activities - Building Lego, Arts & Crafts, Barbies, Magnetic Titles, and Spa. Educators were engaged with the children, sitting at their level, and taking part in play. Educators were also observed prepping the room / hallway, for the children's Graduation week. Children were observed cleaning up their toys, washing their hands, and preparing for lunch. Today's lunch was pasta with red sauce, vegetables, cheese, and a roll. Children were observed sitting at their tables, enjoying their lunch. Positive child guidance techniques were observed – educators were observed giving gentle reminders, offering choices and assisting children in decision-making, using positive reinforcement and encouragement, redirecting negative behaviors, providing appropriate supervision, and using positive language when interacting with the children.
