Comments: Art Materials are depleted, and materials are kept out of reach of the children. Children do not have opportunity to express creativity and their interests. Materials are to be replenished, kept open, down at the child's level and accessible to the children at all times. Deficiency is now compliant			
40(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall ensure that personal belongings of a child receiving services at the licensed facility that are brought to the licensed facility, including combs, brushes, toothbrushes, towels, washcloths, bedding, pacifiers and soothers, are (a) labelled with the name of the child.	40(1)(a)	Oct 28, 2025	Dec 11, 2025
Comments: Two-year-old room - It was observed that diapers and wipes were not labeled. Personal belongings brought into the facility must be clearly labeled with the name of the child to ensure proper identification. Deficiency is now compliant Infants- It was observed that an infant bottle was stored on a shelf without a cover and was not labeled with the child's name. Additionally, bottles stored in the refrigerator were not labeled with the child's name. When an infant is receiving services at a licensed facility, the operator must ensure that each bottle is labeled with the child's name and stored with a cover. Deficiency is now compliant
