General Comments
A Monitoring Inspection was conducted this morning. Children were observed inside, preparing for and eating lunch. Rooms: 0-15 Months - Children were observed during free play, having their bottles, and prepping for lunch. Children's learning is visible through documentation - photographs, individual child binders, learning stories, and webs. 15-18 Months - Children were observed sitting at a table with their educator, playing with fidget / sensory toys. Educator stated that children are presently interested in sensory toys, water play, and mark making. 2's - Children were observed coming inside, after outside water play. Children were wet, and educators were observed assisting children in removing their wet clothing. Wet clothing was placed in the dryer. Children were observed sitting on the floor, with an educator, singing songs. Educators stated that children are presently interested in colors. A color word web was observed on the white board, as well as a colored ball activity on the floor. 3 / 4 - Children were observed sitting at their table, awaiting lunch. Today's lunch was quesadillas, veggies, and potato wedges. Children were observed eating their lunch. Educator stated that the children often enjoy playing as one big group, going to and from activity centers. Educators stated that the children are presently very interested in dramatic play activities. A conversation was had with Administrator regarding the accessibility of art supplies, in the 0–15-month room. Supplies are presently being kept in jars, inside the cupboard. Administrators and educators stated that they would brainstorm some ideas that would make these materials more accessible to children. This will be revisited at the next Monitoring Inspection. Water and milk bottles were labelled with the children's names.
