General Comments

Educators interact with children by engaging in conversation and taking interest in what the children are telling them by asking questions, making comments, etc.. Educators were seen redirecting negative energy and promoting sharing between the children.

There were toxic products being stored in the kitchen with a safety device which is no longer approved as a secure way to keep children out of areas that need to be locked. Please ensure that all toxic products are being stored in a locked area that requires a key.

I discussed transportation with the Operator. Children are only transported for special occasions such as apple picking. Operator and some of the educators stated that staff vehicles are sometimes used. It was discussed with Operator that the driver cannot be counted in ratio, proper restraints are required and a full emergency first aid kit with contacts for the children would have to be present in each car. Also, each vehicle would require the proper amount of liability insurance. Please have each person contact their insurance agent to ensure they are able to transport for daycare purposes.

Educators advised that children are only be taken out in the afternoon. Please ensure that outdoor play is occurring as per regulation.

Please insure that child/staff ratio is being maintained during break times. I observed an educator who was alone with 5 infants for a 20 minute break. During lunch times, staff may take their breaks outside of the room providing that 50% of children are sleeping and educators can be called to come quickly in case of an emergency.
