General Comments

Children were playing outside this morning due to the heat later in the day. Children were reminded to get water regularly and asked if they needed to use the washroom. Children were playing independently throughout the outdoor space, playing running games in the field, swinging on the individual swings and a group on the larger swings chatting, children were climbing and sitting on the climber, some children were playing on the paved area and one child sitting drawing a picture at a picnic table. Children could run inside to use the washroom or fill up water bottles after notifying an educator. To transition back inside, an educator gave a vocal notice to children that they were going inside, and everyone was to clean up four toys and take them to the shed. Children were quick to clean up with this specific request.

Educators have planned the summer curriculum with the children's interests and requests in mind. Children are permitted to bring in their tablets on specific days in the week with times kept for no tablets such as outside or doing activities together. This week is Western week as planned on the monthly calendar with specific activities and ideas included on a weekly schedule. The educators' pre-planning was evident in the calendars and the available resources present for the week's activities. Educators also mentioned they print off coloring sheets and make related games accessible for children based on the week's interest. For Christmas week, a variety of Christmas books were available, and educators were encouraged to pair picture, chapter, and information books for the children's current interests, passions, and the week's topic. Children's artifacts were posted on the walls up and downstairs and a science fact or myth posted on the wall extending interest in science. The resources in each room are accessible to the children and educators set out invitations and invite children to play and create.

While lunches were being heated up, children were reminded to use the washroom and wash their hands before eating. The educators chat with children as they eat.

Staff-to-child ratio was met at all times. Only two educators were required to meet ratio but the third educator allowed educators to have regular breaks and lunches and provide extra support in the rooms throughout the day. There are four washrooms available in the upstairs space for all the children with one being closed for the summer due to lower numbers. The educator stated they use all the washrooms throughout the school year when the number of children is larger, and any resources currently stored in the washroom are removed.
