General Comments

When licensing staff arrived, children were playing in the multiple forts set up while other children were playing with a playhouse. The educator provided a plan of activities for the week with an experiment being conducted each day with children. The educator stated that the educators had created the list previous to March break and

licensing staff made a suggestion to involve children in brainstorming upcoming curriculum ideas and activities possibly creating a web allowing educators and children to reflect and plan.

Educators had resources set up around the room for children and invited children to come to the table and paint their clothes pin wreaths from the day before. A selection of paint and brushes were provided with paper taped to the table. Children were interested in creating new shades and colors and used the paper on the table to mix the paint for their wreaths. Educators took photos of children as they were painting and post on the Centre's private media account for parents. A suggestion would be to take photos of children at play or while creating instead of posing to represent the intentionality of the children at play. Photos can also be posted in the environment for children to see themselves within the space and allow them to re-visit previous learning experiences and extend.

One child was laying on the couch with a blanket and the educators noticed that this was not usual behavior for the child so they checked in several times ensuring they were alright eventually checking their temperature. All health forms were completed and signed by parents. Educators were respectful of children's abilities giving reminders for the washroom and transitions. It was evident children are aware of clean-ups as several children were observed cleaning up when they were done with resources without any prompts or reminders.

Children went outside in the afternoon, and educators were dressed appropriately for the weather modelling the importance of being warm and enjoying the outdoors. When children came in from outside, they washed their hands for their afternoon snack of sundaes with a choice of toppings.

Reminder that all washrooms associated with licence should be available for children, the washroom is currently marked as closed and storing materials. A reminder to parents that any children without a family doctor listed in their child profile can note the local clinic/hospital they visit. The Quality Assurance monitor on postings can be updated to reflect the current monitor, Angela Tozer.
