<p>General Comments</p> <p>Covid-19 screening is very thoroughly done before individuals enter the centre. Temperature taking, signing in, as well as, covid-19 screening questions are being asked.</p> <p>During the renewal inspection licensing staff observed that educators, in the afterschool rooms and in the forest classrooms, were very engaged with the children by interacting at the child's level as well as giving comfort when needed.</p> <p>While licensing staff was outside with the forest school classes the children and educators made icecream in the woods, went sliding on the hills and tracked animal tracks. All the while the educators were asking open-ended questions and encouraged exploring. While tracking animals an eagle was heard screeching and then spotted flying away.</p> <p>While inspecting the indoor space it was noted that cleaning supplies were stored up high and out of reach of children however, according to the Early Childhood Services Act toxics (cleaning supplies) are required to be locked in a cupboard or cabinet (behind lock and key) to ensure they are inaccessible to children. After clarifying the regulation regarding toxics needing to be locked up in a cupboard or cabinet the Director of the centre immediately moved the products and locked them up while licensing staff was still on site.</p> <p>According to the Early Childhood Services Act it states that all educators and Operator must have a Social Development Check, as well as, Criminal Record/Vulnerable Sector Checks done before they can begin</p>

working with children and these checks must be re-done every five years.
