<p>General Comments</p> <p>Licensing staff arrived at the facility to conduct the annual renewal inspection. Staff and children's files were reviewed prior to the children arriving from school.</p> <p>As the children arrived, they independently stored their belongings in their designated cubbies. Upon entering the classroom, they were greeted by their educator, who took attendance. The children then sat at the tables and were offered chocolate in recognition of St. Patrick's Day. Some children also chose to eat snacks remaining from their school lunches.</p> <p>Following snack time, the children gathered in the carpet area with the educator, who facilitated a game of "Categories," where each participant named an item within a given category. Some children were also observed engaging with leprechaun traps they had created the previous day using boxes, craft materials, and recycled items. The educator then transitioned the group to outdoor play. Children dressed appropriately for the weather and formed a line, at which point the educator completed a headcount to ensure proper ratios before heading outside. A first aid kit was brought along in a backpack.</p> <p>Outdoors, children were observed running and playing tag with educators, climbing on play structures, and exploring the snow using shovels.</p> <p>The indoor environment was equipped with a variety of age-appropriate materials, including LEGO, Pokémon cards, books, and building blocks. Children's crafts were displayed on the walls within the environment.</p> <p>Licensing staff will recommend the program for renewal once the deficiency is complaint.</p>
