 -During the visit ratio was respected in a mixed age group and a same age group -Review and discussion about the incident report form. It was discussed with the director what incident is considered reportable -Daily incident log is maintained, and signed by the parent -Incident reports are maintained in the child's file -It was observed during the visit that when in a situation of misunderstanding, children's guidance is done by listening to both parties guidance is provided towards problem solving to allow children to find a solution together. -Allergy information on any child is posted in the food preparation area -Drinking water is provided throughout the day -Food brought from home is labeled with the child's name and refrigerated or has an ice pack as required -In the outdoor play area children have more than one type of surfacing to play and explore, the material offered is varied and in sufficient quantity for children present -Outdoor play area is maintained safe -Staff is presently working on the outside space they are adding into their gardening zone, sand was added into the playground, some work was done on the play structure and staff are planning on bringing more definition into their outside zones. -The outdoor play area has the amount of shade needed for each child based on the maximum number of children that can be accommodated in the outdoor play area Observations: When arriving at the center it was nap time, some were sleeping, and a small group were coloring and cuddling with their educator. Once nap was done, kids got into free play, their biggest interest at the moment are babies, a good part of the room is dedicated to baby care, and it is a very busy spot.
