Comments: During the review of children's files, the inspector observed that 1 out of 6 files was missing parental consent for assistance in cases of illness or soiled clothing. Each child's file must include signed consent from a parent or guardian authorizing staff to provide necessary care, such as cleaning or changing the child, in these situations.

Comments: When the inspector arrived on site, the after-school children were on an outing at the park, as advised by the administrator. The facility presented the inspector the general consent form used for outings. However, the park the children were at was not the one indicated on the consent calendar posted by the door. The operator must ensure that the calendar is consistently kept up to date and that the parents always know where their children are at all times.								
General Comments								
The inspector observed both indoor and outdoor activities during the inspection.								
In one classroom, children were watching a movie, while in another, they were engaged in free play.								
The inspector also discussed with the educator the importance of labeling all children's belongings with their names to ensure proper identification and organization.
