Comments: At time of inspection, licensing staff observed children not washing their hands before eating snack. As per the COVID-19 Guidance document for Early Learning and Childcare Facilities, children and staff are to wash their hands frequently, especially before and after meals.			

General Comments The facility is clean and bright, and is set up in a child-centered way. Positive child guidance and respectful communication between the operator, educators and children were observed. Children's learning is visible through pictures posted on the walls in each classroom, it is recommended that

documentation (pictures, learning stories, etc) be posted at the child's level so that they too can enjoy looking at the documents as well. It should also be noted that documentation posted on walls at the child's level should be laminated (or put in a sort of plastic sleeve) so that it is easily wiped down/sanitized.

Infants are not permitted to be grouped with children of another age group at any time.
