Licensing staff arrived at the licensed Early Learning and Care Home while the children were arriving for the day.

Licensing staff was screened for Covid-19 by signing into the licensed ELC home.

The licensed facility 's indoor and outdoor play spaces are lovely, welcoming and inviting. Licensing staff observed multiple pieces of documentation of learning posted on the walls for the children to re-visit the learning experiences.

On the day of the visit only the preschool children were present at the licensed facility and the operator did not expect any school-aged children later in the afternoon.

The operator was very engaged with the children while the children explored the multiple invitations of play that the operator arranged for the children. licensing staff observed lots of rich dialog between the children and the operator.

While conducting the licensing inspection, licensing staff noted that Lysol wipes present in the bathroom and the indoor play space; even though the Lysol wipes were up high and out of the children's reach, they are required to be secured in a cabinet or closet locked with a lock and key. When this was brought to the attention of the operator, the operator removed the Lysol wipes and locked them up with the other cleaning supplies while licensing staff was still on site.
