General Comments

Upon my arrival, the children were finishing up their lunch. After the children put their lunch bags away, they began to play with some small loose play toys. There is an abundance of material that is readily available to the children. The play material such board games, books, musical instruments, large jars of magnet tiles, a play kitchen with food, and art supplies were organized on shelves or in labeled bins. Children's artwork was on display throughout the main space and a large spooky Halloween house made by the children was on the wall.

Later in the afternoon, the children painted Halloween rocks at the table. The Operator provided paint shirts to keep clothing clean and all of the children sat together. The Operator was actively engaged with the children and was observed asking about their favorite Halloween snacks. Kind words of encouragement and praise were heard about how wonderful all of their rocks turned out. Children who finished their rocks early sat on the couch and played with small wooden memory or skill games. The Operator was observed encouraging the children to tidy up their paints and wash their hands independently.

The children evidently enjoy their time together with the Operator. Giggles were heard and opportunities for engagement and conversation were observed when the group was sitting together around the table naming off costumes and snacks for an alphabet Halloween list.

The parent board was organized and required documentation was visible. The monthly fire drill has been completed and attendance is being recorded. Child and staff files were in order and the daily routine and snack menu was posted.

The outdoor space is large with a lot of trees and pathways. There were bins of outdoor play material that contained bowling pins, balls, trucks, and hula hoops.
