Comments:	Comments: Purposeful planning was not evident within all environments on day of inspection. Some program planning sheets were completed, but evidence that materials and props have been added to the indoor and outdoor environment to support interests and learning is lacking.						
Some program planning sheets demonstrated that children are interested in puzzles and book making within the Forest groups. What could be added to the environment to support this interest? (examples could include but are not limited to: invitations to create a book, create a puzzle, or an ongoing project related to a topic of interest).

Diaper changing procedure was observed during inspection. Staff member did not let disinfectant sit for the required 2 minutes prior to wiping change pad. Staff to review diaper changing procedures. A diaper changing station has been mounted to the side of the garage within the fenced in play area outdoors. Discussed with supervisor on site at time of inspection. Supervisor stated this was installed in approximately June 2020 and is used for diaper changing during the spring and summer months. ELC licensing staff consulted with Public Health inspector who stated they have no record of this change and did not approve diaper changing outdoors or the installation of this equipment. Changing station to be removed. Dishes were noted to be drying within the sink in the infant room. This sink is used for hand washing and is routinely used for handwashing following diaper changing. Dishes should not be washed within this sink.

General Comments

Renewal inspection completed today.

Children were observed inside Lisa's Playhouse as well as within the forest cabins and outdoors.

Children within the preschool classroom were observed to be engaged in mark making, and building with blocks with their educators. Some children were engaged in dramatic play (playing doctor) as well. Materials and props have been added to the dramatic play area to support this interest.

A child was noted to be interested in a documentation binder that was being reviewed by licensing staff today. Recommending that these binders be stored on low, accessible shelving for the children to review these as they wish. This promotes a sense of belonging and supports the children's connections to their environment and others.

Educators were observed engaging with the children at their level throughout the facility today. In one of the forest cabins, a child had taken an interest in reading to their peers. The educators supported this interest and provided the child with praise and encouragement.

General Comments

Purposeful planning was discussed with educators in the Forest today. Educators should be setting up the environment with a variety of accessible, well organized and open ended materials (inside and in the forest). The forest is a great place for dramatic play to occur, however, the materials and props for the mud kitchen are not set up in an organized way that is inviting to the children. Invitations should be set up for the children to explore daily.

All staff must be well informed of any children within the facility who have medical conditions and procedures to be taken in case of an emergency. Discussions with staff demonstrated that some educators were not fully informed about a child within their group with a diagnosed medical condition. Recommended that parents complete the Essential Routine Services and Emergency Plan and that a copy is reviewed by educators. A copy could be kept within the room and also should be taken when the child leaves the facility (ex: to go on a walk).

A child's workbook was observed within the filing cabinet today in the cabin. This is being used to practice letters and numbers and is sent back and fourth between home and the facility. Work sheets/work books/ lessons are not to be used in this way to promote children's learning. Learning should be based on children's interests and the NB curriculum framework for early learning and childcare and not on the NB education system curriculum outcomes. This should not be a part of the child's daily routine at an early learning and childcare facility.
