General Comments

Monitoring inspection completed today. Children were preparing for outdoor play when licensing staff arrived.

Environments are set up with a variety of materials that are accessible to children. Documentation is posted in the form of photos, art and learning stories. Some structured art projects observed in some rooms. Consider providing art experiences in the same way you offer free-play experiences. Provide a variety of materials and observe and document how children engage with those materials.

Outdoors children were planting vegetable seeds. They shared with licensing staff what they were planting and engaged in conversation about favourite vegetables. Licensing staff observed children having a long wait time as educators prepared for planting. Consider how you can provide other materials for children during wait times or engage them in songs, games, or a story.

General Comments

Recommendation to rake mulch under the climbing dome as it is quite compacted.

As discussed with administrator, facilities have a duty to accommodate children in care. For children who may be transitioning to a new room, changes to the daily schedule and routines may be necessary until the child becomes better acquainted with the new group, or if additional supports are required, until those supports are in place.
