<p>Monitoring inspection completed today.</p> <p>Children and educators were observed in the indoor and outdoor play environment and during transition times.</p> <p>Environments were observed to have a variety of materials available and accessible to the children in clearly defined interest centres.</p> <p>Documentation posted in the environments highlight children's activities and learning with observations and connections to the curriculum framework included.</p> <p>Photos of children and families displayed creates a sense of belonging. Photos of staff posted at the entry with fun facts creates an inviting and welcoming display for families.</p> <p>As discussed, product directed art and colouring sheets are not a best practice and do not provide opportunities for children to explore their creativity and demonstrate their knowledge and interests in the same way process created art does. Children should be provided with a variety of materials daily to create with that are accessible and available during free play time.</p> <p>Educators should engage and document with children regarding their ideas and process as they create with open-ended art and sensory materials.</p>

QA Monitor will provide resources to share during in-house professional learning that will be offered in November.

Ensure mulch under swings and play structure is raked daily to appropriate depth to ensure the safety of the children.
