Comments: It has been observed that the materials available in the outdoor play area are insufficient. Additions are required to ensure the presence of various types of materials and equipment aimed at stimulating different activities and interests of the children.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Visit completed at the facility in the afternoon for a monitoring inspection. - During the visit, ratio was respected. Infants are only mixed with preschool age children outside the hours of 8:30am to 4:30pm. - Twelve out of 28 children's files have been reviewed, both the profile and consent forms are completed properly. - The operator maintains the outdoor play area in safe conditions. There is no stationary equipment in the outdoor play area. - Observations: Upon my arrival all children were napping. <p>Infant room: Following nap time, infants woke up and were fed milk from their bottles. Educators were actively engaged on the floor, holding, comforting, and talking to the infants,</p> <p>2-year-old room: After waking from nap, children participated in a variety of activities including playing musical instruments, creating art, and exploring books.</p> <p>3-4-year-old room: Children were gradually waking from their nap and engaging in art activities. Educators were interacting with the children through conversation</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Discussion with the operator on the outdoor play area.
