General Comments

Licensing staff conducted a license renewal inspection today.

While conducting the license renewal inspection, licensing staff observed all educators engaged with the children at the child's level.

Monthly Fire Drills have been conducted each month.

Multiple examples of the children's learning were posted in each classroom. While observing in the 3-year-old classroom, licensing staff noted a learning story posted on the wall where the children were dressed up as chefs and engaging in a cooking activity. While speaking with one of the educators in this room, licensing staff learned that the children wrote their own story by looking at the pictures in a "wordless book."

While observing in the 2-year-old classroom, the educators transitioned from outside play to the indoors to have lunch. The transition consisted of the educators and the children reading story books as well as singing a number of songs while each child went to the bathroom to wash their hands. This was a very smooth transition for the children.

While observing in the preschool classrooms located on the first floor, licensing staff noted that the indoor classrooms were very well organized and consisted of very distinct learning centres such as: loose parts, block, dramatic play, art, cozy corner, and sensory play centres. The educators and children were engaging in outdoor play activities. The educators were engaged with the children throughout their play.
