General Comments

This facility is following Covid-19 Recovery Phase document's recommendations. I was screened at arrival and temperature recorded. Each child has a family log and a record of morning and 5 hour updated temperatures. Cleaning is done by educators daily and additional cleaning by recreation employees mid-day and evening. Children and educators were observed washing their hands several times and children enjoyed singing as they washed.

The outdoor space at this facility has a variety of natural elements such as a rock corner, a full size boat, a wooden hut, a wooden walking bridge and much more. The children are independent outside exploring this area and educators regularly engage in conversation and play with the children.

General Comments

There was more than enough educators present. The added educators allowed two educators to participate in a PL event online supporting their learning and counting towards hours required for designation.

Staff files, child files and required records are organized and easily accessible by staff only missing some minor items. A relief staff, not regularly at this centre was present today and did not have their criminal record check/vulnerable sector check in the file located on-site.

This facility continues to offer children opportunities to explore, investigate, and succeed. I viewed educators getting down to children's level to ask questions and respond.
