Comments: Child-to-staff ratio is not maintained when educators under the age of 19 are left alone with children.

Comments: A 16 year old was left unsupervised.			
33(2) Stationary equipment in the outdoor play area shall be surrounded by a protective surfacing and installed according to the manufacturer's instructions.	33(2)	Aug 05, 2022	
Comments: The surfacing around the play structure needs to be tilled. If it does not meet 30 cm with a 6 foot encroachment zone, more sand will be required.			
9(1) The child-to-staff ratio is one educator for each of the following groups of children of the same age receiving services at a full-time or part-time early learning and childcare centre: (a) three infants or fewer; (b) five children or fewer who are two years of age; (c) eight children or fewer who are three years of age; (d) ten children or fewer who are four years of age or older, but who are not yet attending school; and (e) 15 school-age children or fewer.	9(1)	Jul 25, 2022	
Comments: There was a 16 year old educator who was being left alone with the children while the other educator was putting the children down for nap. A 16 year old can be used to maintain ratio but can never be left alone with the children at any time.			
9(2) An educator under 19 years of age shall be supervised at all times when he or she is working directly with a child by an educator who is at least 19 years of age.	9(2)	Jul 25, 2022	
Comments: A 16 year old was left unsupervised.			

General Comments

The facility appears more organized and clean. There are many learning centres and materials readily available to the children. The children's learning is documented by picture boards, artwork, and learning stories. Educators continuously encourage and support the children in everything they are doing.

The changes to the outdoor play space are inviting. There are many developmentally appropriate centres set up such as a building, music, mud kitchen, truck, and boat centres. There is also a beautiful natural shaded area that enhances the environment.
