## **General Comments**

The facility is very open and inviting with lots of natural materials. Resources are provided on open shelves easily accessible by the children. There is a reading shelf in each room that the children enjoyed choosing from. The reading shelves have large rugs and cushions in front of them so children can get comfortable. The space was very clean and children were independent within the environment.

An invitation was set up for each group today. The older group waited patiently for a painting invitation that allowed them a choice of colors of paint and a variety of painting utensils. The educator was attentive to the children discussing the shades of color and what happened as colors mixed.

The younger children engaged in an invitation with nuts, bolts, and magnetics. They created various shapes as they sat with two educators discussing the different poles of magnetics by using hugging versus pushing away, a great introductory lesson to physics.

Each group went outside today enjoying the outdoor play space and the surrounding field for some running and playing.

The educators were observed to be very kind and attentive to children. During a read aloud, the educator sat with the children in front and cuddled beside to read a book. The educator took their time allowing children to comment on the pages as she asked open-ended questions. One educator engaged in some dancing with children choosing their favorite songs.

It is evident children are familiar with the routine as they transitioned to outside and hand washing for lunch. Recent documentation was posted in each room showing the love of paint within the centre and exploration with colors and shapes inside and outside. An important component of documentation is representing the value of learning through play in and outside.
