## **General Comments**

Upon licensing staff arrival for the annual renewal, children were observed actively engaged in gross motor play, running across the large open field located behind the playground. Educators were present and involved, supporting and supervising the children as they played. After this period of active play, the children transitioned into the designated outdoor play area.

Within this space, children were observed climbing and pretending on the wooden pirate ship, engaging in dramatic play in the outdoor play kitchen where they prepared and "served" food, and sliding down the play structure. Others played with toy cars, while some gathered around the sand area, using shovels and bowls to dig, scoop and create. The outdoor environment also included a music wall and climbing structures, both of which provided further opportunities for sensory exploration and physical activity. Children remained engaged until it was time to prepare for lunch.

At lunchtime, children were observed lining up along the outdoor wall in an orderly manner before transitioning indoors. Once inside, children washed their hands and grabbed their lunch boxes to eat at the tables. Educators then facilitated a quiet group activity by reading a story aloud to the children. Following this, tables were cleaned, and part of the group transitioned to rest time, lying down for naps, while the remainder of the children returned outdoors to continue playing in the designated play area. An educator was observed supervising the children during rest time.

The indoor classroom environment was observed to be tidy and organized. Documentation was displayed prominently on the walls, including children's self-portrait activity and a sock sensory project. Family photographs were also visible. Labels and stickers identifying items and areas were posted throughout the classroom to support early literacy and independence.

The room incorporated natural elements and offered a variety of materials. These included books, toy cars, building blocks, dolls, puzzles, dress-up costumes, as well as designated areas for creative expression such as a craft table and a play kitchen.

Staff and child files were verified, and positive child guidance was observed throughout the inspection.
