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General Comments Monitoring Inspection: Children and educators observed engaged in a variety of activities this morning including stories, outdoor play, dramatic play, open-ended art, and building. The children from the Two/Three Room were observed exploring the outdoor play area. A small group was engaged in digging, scooping, filling, and dumping using a variety of pots, pans, and utensils. Another group was experimenting with tires by rolling them down the hill and observing how they moved at different speeds and directions. Educators actively circulated throughout the outdoor play area, maintained awareness of all children, and engaged with them throughout their play. The children in the Three/Fours Room spent the morning at the local splash pad; they were observed during the transition to lunch. When they arrived, they changed out of their swimming gear, washed their hands and joined a story time until their lunches were warmed up. The indoor play areas are organized and maintained. A variety of accessible materials are available to support children's interests and play, creating an inviting and engaging learning environment. Purposeful planning is evident through documentation displayed throughout the environments. The documentation in the Three/Fours is in need of updating; documentation is current on Class Dojo however it is not displayed for children to revisit within their environment. Handwashing routines were observed after outdoor play, during washroom routines and before mealtimes. Daily attendance records are accurate and reflect all children present. Child-to-staff ratio was observed to be met during Monitoring Inspection. New staff file (2) review was completed; all required documents are in place. Facility is currently meeting the 50% trained Early Childhood Educators (4/6) requirement.
