## **General Comments**

Renewal Inspection performed.

\*Covid Recovery Phase Guidelines are not being followed. Signage and clear rules must be posted at all doors regarding entrance requirements. Even after prompting, I wasnot screened prior to entry or temperature checked. I will email the amended copy of the covid-19 Recovery Phase guidelines dated August 17th. I would strongly recommend that all staff read the contents. This includes the new screening questionnaire. Please update your operational plan to reflect the changes effective August 17th. Educators must keep a daily group log (refer to a sample group log Appendix C) where the educator can record children's names, staff name and record temperatures. All parents are required to sign Appendix E regarding their responsibility to screen their children in the AM. Of the files reviewed not all parents signed the form. Household member list is was not available upon request for contact tracing purposes. Please ensure this is completed. A master list would be appropriate for easy access in the event of an outbreak. A well developed cleaning schedule is being tracked for indoors.

\*With the newly developed outdoor playspace/outdoor gym, I would recommend that a maintenance checklist be created based on the fencing, gates, pergola, other equipment an storage of and disinfecting cleaning record established.

\*Due to Covid, currently the centre is not providing transportation, however the operator is licensed to operate and transport children from school to the centre. Please read the updates regarding transportation in the Covid recovery phase guidelines and grouping method.

\*children were observed involved in a variety of active play opportunities, participating table top activities, washing hands, eating snacks an lunches. Staff were observed engaged and interacting with children and providing instructions. Please ensure children get outdoors at least every 4 hour block of time.
