## **General Comments**

On the afternoon of my monitoring visit, the younger afterschoolers played outdoors before snack. Some children enjoyed the plasma cars and played four-square while others were playing in the small wooded area adjacent to the parking lot. Please organize the two storage containers that hold the outdoor materials. There are some items that need discarded (broken pool noodles, broken handle on skipping rope.) I did see materials that the children would benefit from having access to- dishes for mud play, balls, and hockey sticks. The bins should be pulled out from under the deck and organized so children can easily choose different materials. I also saw new materials inside at the top of the stairs that are going to be added to the outdoor space and those will add to the variety of what is currently out there.

While checking the indoor space, I saw wasp spray on the desk and two BBQ lighters on a shelf in the kitchen. When notifying the on site supervisor of this, she immediately locked them up.

The snack served was cheese, crackers, apples and water. The educator made a nicely displayed tray for each table and the children could independently serve themselves. This was a great addition to the snack routine for this age group.

After snack, children had different activities to choose from. I observed children playing Pokémon cards, doing an art activity, relaxing in the reading area and talking with their friends.

I noted all positive child guidance practices during my visit. The educators were friendly, caring and engaged with the children. I saw them laughing with the children and comforting them when needed.
