General Comments

The group has been doing activities and projects surrounding kindness for the last month. A kindness tree, compliment box, kindness poster and kindness bingo were planned for the children.

The educators shared with licensing staff that during the late winter there were leaks in two rooms. Neither licensing staff nor Public Health were notified when the leak occurred. Please contact both departments in the event of leaks.

A humidifier was running in the main room at the top of the stairs. The paint was peeled on a vertical section of wall. While on site, licensing staff contacted Public Health for next steps required. When possible, open the windows and keep the dehumidifier running to keep air moving. The vertical piece of wall needs to be repaired and painted. Additional general information about leaks and air quality shared by Public Health will be sent by licensing staff to the administrator.

While waiting for the children to arrive, the educator prepared the outdoor play space with materials for later in the afternoon- bubbles, chalk, badminton racquets and birdies were placed outdoors. Wooden bins are also outdoors for additional materials to remain outdoors- balls and skipping ropes. Planned programming was also implemented outside- children could create a stick puzzle and work on a collaborative art mural.

Before snack, children had free time. Children were playing board games, making a craft, playing Barbies. Educators remained engaged with the children asking them about their day at school. Child guidance remained positive throughout the inspection and educators used redirection and reminders when needed.

General Comments

Snack was trail mix, apples, bananas and water. The correct menu was posted on the parent information board. Children were offered additional servings if still hungry.
