When this was brought to the attention of the Director, the Director put a mat over the area until the flooring is replaced.

General Comments
<p>The children were outside playing when licensing staff arrived for the licensing renewal inspection. Once the children went back indoors, licensing staff observed in each classroom. The children ate their snack and then prepared to go on a nature walk. The children put sunscreen on and the educators, in each classroom, ensured the children had full water bottles for their walk.</p> <p>The children arrived back at the centre in time to have lunch and have a nap (for those children who nap). Once the napping children woke up the groups headed to the public pool for the afternoon.</p> <p>The educators, in each classroom, are very kind and compassionate. The educators were seen engaging with the children at the child's level and encouraged the children using positive child guidance techniques.</p> <p>While inspecting in one classroom, licensing staff noted an undiluted cleaning solution not stored in a cupboard</p>

or closet that is secured by a lock and key. When this was brought to the Directors attention she moved the cleaning products and ensured they were secured behind a lock and key.

Licensing staff observed on the outdoor playground and noted a dome that needs to have more pea rock placed underneath, as well as, around it in order to comply with either the manufacturers manual recommendation or the Consumer Product Safety Act Canada. When this was brought to the attention of the Director, the Director removed the dome from the playground until more pea rock can be placed around and underneath it.

Licensing staff also noted a number of cement blocks with posts laying underneath the ramp that pose as a safety hazard and will need to be removed. When this was brought to the Director's attention she removed these from the playground before licensing staff left the centre.
