General Comments

The rooms were well organized and well-stocked with art supplies, toys, and books. These were available at the children's level for them to explore.

During snack the educators readily supported the children with opening food when asked and with gentle prompts to follow the classroom rules like sitting at the table while eating.

The children were very comfortable approaching their educators to ask questions and to ask for assistance. Educators were patient and encouraging with the children, particularly during transitions and difficult emotional moments.

Educators allowed time for free exploration as well access to coordinated art activities, reading, and games.
