<p><b>General Comments</b></p> <p>On the morning of the monitoring inspection, all rooms were engaged in different activities. I observed the 3-year-old room having circle time and singing songs. The educators set out snow sensory bins in the classroom and they had spray bottles prepared with colored water for the children to use in the outdoor play space later that day.</p> <p>In the three-year-old room, a sandwich baggie with a child's Advil was on the attendance clipboard on the counter. The educator had another staff member lock it up in the medication box. Please ensure that medication is locked up immediately when the child is dropped off. The medication must also be in the original container.</p>
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General Comments

In the two Ready for School classrooms, children had various stations and activities that focused on numeracy. Children traced and printed the number 9. Educators worked patiently with children on holding their pencils. After snack, there was a mitten and dabber game, a pom-pom counting game, and a third station with a number line and post-it notes.

The educators used positive child guidance techniques to comfort, praise, and re-direct children. I heard transition songs, comforting words and children were spoken to at their level in a nurturing, low voice. There were lots of high-fives and words of encouragement.
