General Comments

Upon Licensing Staff arrival, it was noted that the entry way was bright and inviting with children's photos colourful drawings. Both the 3-year-old room and the 4-year-old room were getting ready to go outside. The 4-year-old room lined up outside their classroom and an Educator was observed at the children's level asking if they remembered where the special spot to race to on the playground was. The children were excited to go outside and play, making the transition smooth.

Once outside, both age groups of children were observed playing on the play structure, with a basketball and net, baking a cake with mud using pots and pans, and playing tag. Positive words of encouragement and child guidance were observed as well as a caring hug after a small tumble from the monkey bars.

The indoor play space for the 3-year-old room was organized and tidy. Family photos were displayed on the wall as well children's artwork. Throughout the room, there were labeled toy bins that contained, wooden blocks, cars, magnet toys and art supplies. It is recommended that ripped or torn books be removed from the shelf, and new books added.

The indoor play space for the 4-year-old room was also very organized and tidy. Summer popsicle and icecream cone artwork projects were on display and a "what to bring camping" with suggestions was on a flipchart with a campfire drawing. For dramatic play, there is a large indoor playhouse with streamers hanging and a play kitchen. There were clearly labelled stations for art, Lego, toys and board games.

During my inspection, Educators were preparing for afternoon carnival games. It's evident that the Educators take pride in the daily routine and activities. Children's carnival game decorations, prizes, entry bracelets and were being organized and set up.

Staff and child files were in order and contained required documentation.
