<p>General Comments</p> <p>Licensing Staff arrived at the facility to conduct a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival, one small group of children were napping in a classroom while a larger group of children were engaged in tabletop activities in another room. The two classes have combined for the week of March Break due to low attendance.</p> <p>The children who do not nap were observed playing with kinetic sand. The children brought materials such as pots, pans, bowls, spoons and whisk from the play kitchen to the tables. They used their imagination, working together to make a variety of food, placing it by the window to "cook". A new art table and chairs have recently been added to the classroom. The children were observed drawing using markers, pencil crayons on a large piece of chart paper. Several large pieces of colorful, collaborative artwork were displayed throughout the classroom.</p> <p>Later in the afternoon, the children who were napping joined the larger class. The children voted on having a dance party. A gentle reminder was heard before the class cleaned up for snack time. There are several mini brooms and dustpans that the children used to help sweep up any kinetic sand from under the tables. Once all materials were put away, the children lined up to wash their hands. The tables were cleaned before and after snack time.</p> <p>Only positive child guidance was observed. The Educators spoke kindly and respectfully with the children. It is evident there's a mutual respect between the children and Educators. The Educators were actively involved with the children, dancing and laughing with the children and sitting at the tables engaged in their play with the kinetic sand. The classrooms were bright, organized and welcoming. Family pictures, a birthday wall and pictures of the children engaged in play were observed throughout the facility. Attendance records were reviewed and are being used properly. Incident reports are also being documented and signed by parents.</p>
