Comments: During the monitoring inspection the QA monitor observed a child sleeping on a bench outside in the play area without direct supervision. The QA monitor questioned the educator about the child sleeping on the bench. The educator said that she assumed that the child was just tired and that she texted the parent but had no response. The QA monitor informed the educator that the child's temperature should be taken to better assess the child's needs and to ensure the child isn't ill. After about 15 minutes the educator returned with a								
thermometer. After taking his temperature, the child had a high fever. The QA monitor informed the educator that the parent should be contacted and asked to pick up their child. Within 10 minutes, a parent was reached and was on its way. The educator filled the potential illness form and supervised the child while waiting for the parent to arrive.								
	The Staff needs to be able to recognize the signs and symptoms that a child may be ill to manage the illness. A ny child who become ill while attending the facility need to be supervised and separated from other children.
