Comments: 2 infants were lying down for a nap with each a milk bottle. Educator immediately removed their bottles. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: One infant milk bottle was not identified with their name. The educator did put the name of the infant on the milk bottle. Deficiency is now compliant
