This was addressed with the educators. An educator immediately brought a variety/sufficient amount of outdoor play materials for the children to use. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: Not all water bottled are labelled with the child's name. This was addressed with an educator, who verified all children water bottles and labelled them as needed. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: A medication brought from home is not labelled with the child's name. The medication was labelled with the child's name during the inspection. Deficiency is now compliant							
General Comments							

A conversation was had between the Inspector and the Administrator regarding a child's expired EpiPen. Administrator shares with the Inspector the current plan for this child and will reach out to the parent with regards to returning the EpiPen to them.

Inspector and Administrator discussed the use of the stationary equipment during the winter. Administrator indicates that the children do use the stationary equipment on occasion and an ice pic is used to eliminate the ice around the equipment. Inspector shares concerns with Administrator regarding the use of the stationary equipment when there is a lack of protective surfacing. Inspector recommends that Administrator contact their Page 1 of 2
